- Create network of people and organisations engaged on hydrography and its related sciences.

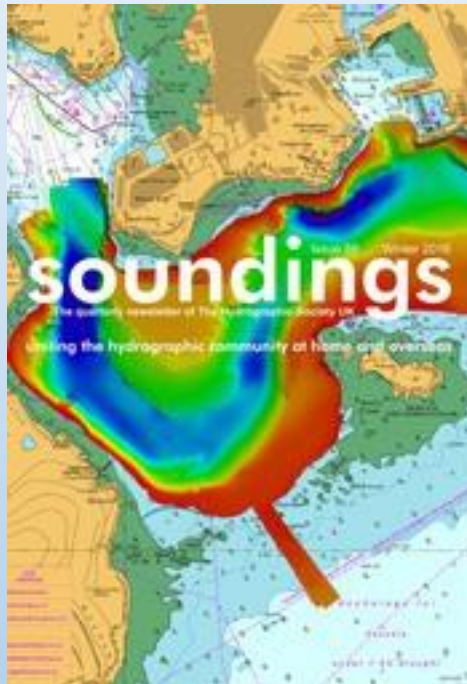

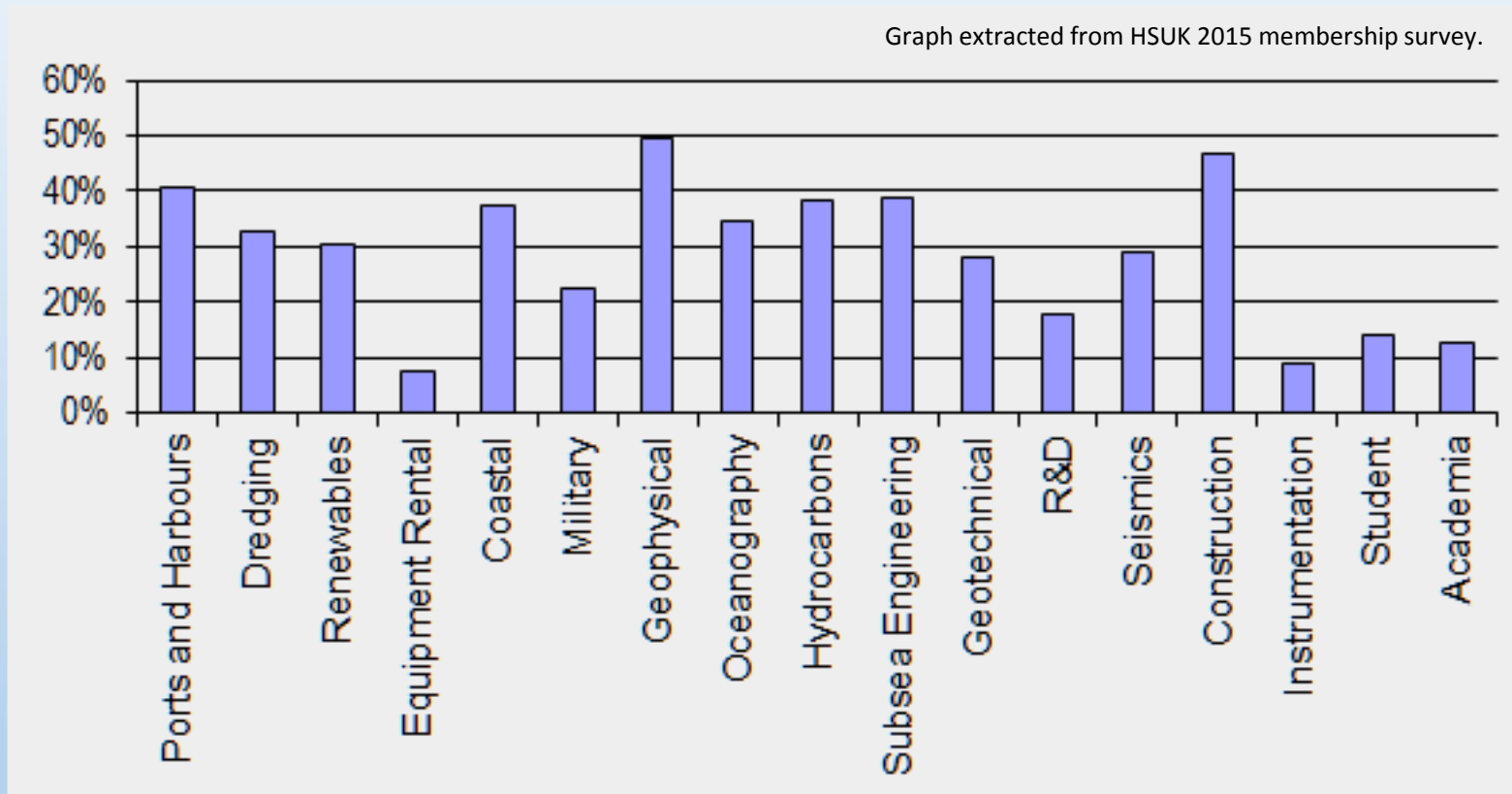

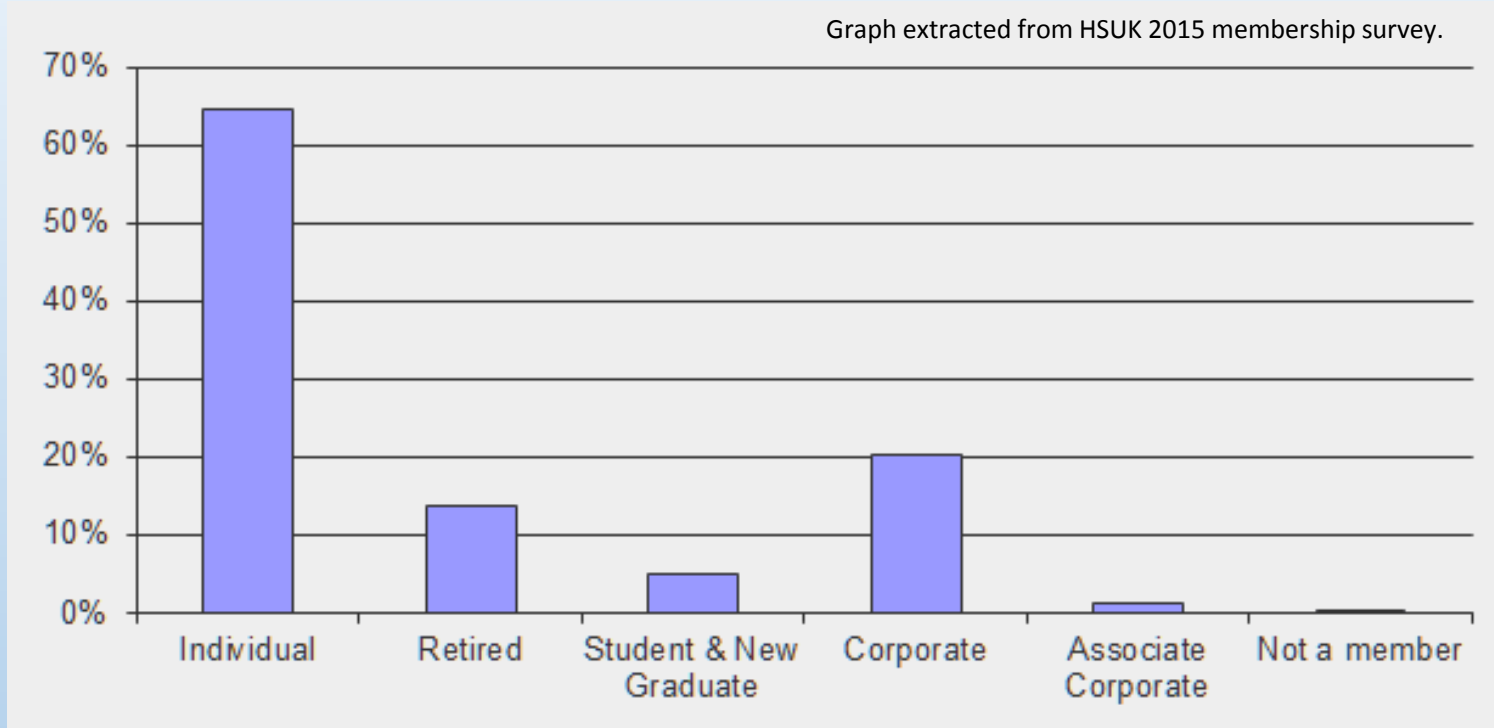
Industry sectors in which members have or are currently working
