IOGP Americas is working to:

- Advance our Members' interests in the region by promoting the adoption and value of IOGP's initiatives and offerings.
- Serve as advocates for the industry, engaging in meaningful dialogues with regulators and policymakers to address technical matters and policy considerations.
- Foster collaboration with fellow trade associations to establish consensus and endorse shared policy goals, thereby reducing duplication of recommended practices and maximizing alignment across associations.

Over the past five years, we have co-organized more than eight dialogues with national regulators, in alignment with these three goals. Our targeted focus countries for 2024-2025 include Argentina, Brazil, Canada, Guyana, Suriname, and the USA. Join us in shaping the future of the industry.

Eliminating fatalities

IOGP has a long history of working to improve health and safety in the industry and is committed to eliminating upstream fatalities.

We aim to foster collaboration and knowledge-sharing in order to enhance health and safety practices. Our work includes the development of recommended practices, benchmarking and data sharing, identifying emerging trends, and challenges of specific regional interest.

Some of our key IOGP safety recommended practices include the Life-Saving Rules, Process Safety Fundamentals, aviation and land transport guidelines. We strive for continuous improvement in health and safety performance across the industry.

Energy Transition

The global oil and gas industry, as part of the energy transition, is focusing on decreasing energy use, increasing operational efficiency, and reducing greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions. IOGP's Energy Transition Directorate supports the implementation of low carbon practices and solutions for scope 1 and 2 emissions reduction for existing and new offshore and onshore oil and gas facilities.

Our Integrated Framework encompasses the full scope of our activities and provides an entry point to the supporting resources, including those from IOGP as well as from other organizations including OGCI, Ipieca, Methane Guiding Principles, and API.

It includes our newly released methane detection and quantification technology filtering tool, which enables operators to select the best available technologies suitable for a specific site, and our Energy Transition Toolkit for upstream oil and gas scope 1 and 2 decarbonization.

Engineering

Engineering is at the heart of the oil and gas industry and plays an integral role in delivering safe and competitive projects, keeping the barrels flowing and our plants reliable. Reducing complexity and controlling project and operating cost are among the biggest challenges facing our industry.

Collaboration among major operators to identify, align and sponsor activities, such as standardization, is key to our sector remaining competitive and relevant.

IOGP plays a crucial role in advancing industry standards, fostering collaboration, and driving technological advancements in areas such as the Low Carbon agendas (including CCS, H₂, and methane projects).
